Eligibility: Your organization is eligible to receive one grant if it:

1. Operates in Imperial County in support of Imperial county students.
2. Has been operating within the Imperial Valley for at least one year.
3. Has a significant agricultural, business or leadership component to its mission.
4. NEW in 2020: Willing to sell one sponsorship for the Ag Expo at the \$400 level. Funds from this sponsorship help support the Grant and Scholarship programs while it promotes participation in the Ag Expo within the agricultural community.
5. Willing to provide appropriate volunteer support to the 2020 Ag Expo. (1-2 April, 2020)

Components of the grant application:

1. This form, completed manually or electronically. (The form is best completed electronically in Word)
2. Two letters from participants in the program, highlighting the value and results of the programs.
3. Written accounting of student participation in the program over the last three years. (Please use objective measurement of participation- Names of students are not necessary)
4. Documentation of the organization that operates your program. Example: school, national organization etc. (Establish your organization's legitimacy)
5. NOTE: Grant offers may be void if the volunteer or sponsorship sales commitments are not met.

Process and Schedule:

1. Process: Once your application has been received, you will receive an email confirming your participation. Your application will then be evaluated by a panel of agricultural business and education professionals selected by Rollins Creative They will establish qualification and rank you based on our criteria. The applicant finalists may or may not receive a call to appear before the panel this is up to the discretion of the panel. If one of the board members is a member of your organization or a close relative, they will not participate in the evaluation process.
2. Schedule: Application packets must be scanned, emailed and received by Rollins Creative (rollinscreative3@gmail.com) by midnight pacific standard time on March 13th, 2020.
